



Minutes Fall Outdoor league May 23<sup>rd</sup>:

The following items were discussed and decided at Sunday's meeting:

1) Shari and Frank (which means Shari) have agreed to take the team applications and \$50 deposits (thanks Shari). I have attached the application so if you are entering a team please get them to Shari as soon as you can.

2) Applications will be distributed to CNYJSA coaches (thanks Brian) and will be posted on the website the next time it's updated.

3) All coaches in this league are required to complete the online Risk Management Certification before the start of the season. Click on the attached link.

4) We have been given approval by a number of townships to use their fields for the league games on Saturdays. We are asking everyone to make an attempt to secure additional fields, we would rather have too many than not enough and we don't know how many teams/divisions will sign up. If we wind up with more teams than field availability the back up plan is to add an additional day of the week to schedule games on.

5) There was discussion about age matrix and Frank told me tonight that it is wrong on the RSSC website and they are in the process of updating the site with the correct age matrix. In the mean time he told me we could look at the CNYJSA site, theirs is correct and is the same as the one we will be using. If there are any questions please e-mail or call Shari.

6) Brian Berringer prepared the league by-laws and had a few questions for Frank and the group and a final version will be presented to the RSSC Board of Directors at their next meeting for approval. Once approved they will be posted on the RSSC website.

7) The U9 and U10 divisions will play 8 v 8 and the maximum roster size will be 14. These age groups will be playing on U10 sized fields.

8) The U11 and U12 divisions will play 9 v 9 and the maximum roster size will be 16. These age groups will play on U12 sized fields.

9) We discussed some ideas the RSSC board had on ways we could partner with AYSO and include:

- \* Shared clinics for kids (including goalie specific), coaches and referees.
- \* Indoor winter recreation leagues available to AYSO registered players a reduced rate.

We have received feedback that they also would be open to discussing mutually beneficial ways to work together for the benefit of the children in our communities.

10) Frank attempted to explain the banner program. Bottom line is you get \$100 off one team application to be used in the Fall, Winter OR Spring season for every banner your team sells. There are two different size banners with different costs. Please see the website for additional banner program information and/or contact Shari with questions.
