

Minutes RSJSL August 16th

We had an excellent turnout last night and the meeting went very well. The following is a list of items that were discussed, decided and need to be finalized before our first league game:

- 1) All RSSC Club teams need to stop by the facility this coming Monday (8/23) between 6:00 and 7:15 to pick up their team player books.
- 2) I spoke to Frank on Tuesday and he told me that the RSSC Club is going to pick up the \$450 referee scheduler's fee this season. Teams will not be assessed a \$1 per game fee as discussed at the meeting.
- 3) The referee will cost will be \$38 per game for the U10 teams and \$42 per game for the U11 and U12 teams (to be split equally between the two teams).
- 4) We need every team in this league to find at least one person who will volunteer to stripe fields if/when necessary. Please e-mail me the name and number of your volunteer and I will make a list, start at the top and work my way through so the task is evenly assigned. If anyone has striping equipment that could be used by our league please let me know that as well.
- 5) We will ask a parent from each team to be a sideline judge at each game.
- 6) Teams must show up for every game regardless of weather. A determination whether or not the game will be played will be made by the referee at the scheduled game time and location.
- 7) We decided on two 25 minute halves to allow for a five minute half time and five minutes for referees to fill out a USSF game report.
- 8) We all agreed to tell our players no slide tackling in games.
- 9) We all voted for consolation games. The more soccer the better was the concensus.
- 10) Championship games will be played under the lights at Proctor Park the week of October 25th.
- 11) In the playoffs there will be two full periods of overtime played, not to exceed 15 minutes each, followed by a shoot out if the game is still tied.
- 12) Vinny Chiffy has secured a U10 and a U12 field for us to use on Wednesday nights for games. They will be in the same location and will be used for U10 Girls games and U12 boys games if we don't get one additional team in thier respective divisions. This will avoid conflicts with our referee's schedules.

13) Frank and Shari are looking into whether or not an all AYSO team can play in this league without having to get player passes.

14) Ed Kobos will be providing any other referee related decisions we have to make and will also let us know how the other leagues handle these items. Since we won't be having another meeting before the season starts we will go with how the others handle it for the Fall and can make any necessary modifications by vote at meetings we have prior to the start of the Spring season.

15) There will be one Thursday night game on Sept. 9th.

16) Thursdays can be practice nights for RSSC teams, if they need a location to practice, with the exception of the 2 nights the field is being used (we have a game and the 1 night that modified is playing there).

17) **I will be making some last minute modifications to the schedules so please don't hand out the one's you were given last night. I will get you all an electronic version of the official schedule by this weekend at the latest and it should be pretty close to what you have now.**
