

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR PLAYOFFS

Final Standings and an Extra Game Played

All teams final records in any division will be based on those teams playing an equal number of games during the season. Some teams may be scheduled to play an extra game at the end, but the result of that game counts only for the team you are playing against!

Final Standing Tie Breaker System

The following system will be used when 2 or more teams are tied in the Final Standings:

1. Head-to-Head Competition
2. Goal Differential in their Head-to-Head
3. Most Overall Wins
4. Record Against the Same Opponents
5. Coin Flip

Length of Games

All games will consist of 2 – 20 minute halves

Playoff Tie Breaker System

The following system will be used when breaking a tie after regulation time:

1. A coin toss will determine which team kicks first.
2. At the end of regulation, each team will take one player out and play a one minute sudden victory overtime period.
3. In each subsequent period, each team alternates kick-off and will take one more player out until there are a minimum of 3 players, one of which must be a goalkeeper who must dress differently from the other teammates. Continue to play one minute periods with 3 players until one team scores. The game is over when one team scores.
